


#### **Configuration Palette**


The top portion of the configuration palette contains tabs which control the view in the main window.


The bottom portion contains media configuration options. The user can cycle through options using the right arrow.



#### **Current Tab**


Selecting this tab defaults the main window to whichever task tab is currently selected as shown to the left. (Media Manager, Copy to Device, or Downloads). The user may alternately select a main task tab to switch to current tab view.





#### **Box Art Tab**

Selecting this tab changes the main window to a view of the box art of the currently playing media.




#### Video Tab


Displays currently playing video. If no video is playing, tab is inactive.






The Media Shelf View simulates browsing the shelves of a store or home library with the advantages of advanced filtering. Users may browse content by visually scanning boxes and key art to find content.

#### **Filter Content**

Boxes / CD cases displayed as in store. User can browse through sections. Selected box displays in media detail area.


The Equalizer View is an interface toy that allows the user to find content they would not otherwise find browsing through linear categories. In the case of video, each piece of content is rated on a scale of 1- 10 in the following categories: Comedy, Romance, Action, Realism, Time Period. By adjusting these sliders the user is presented with unusual combinations of content to explore.

The user can further filter content by choosing categories of media type (Movies, Documentaries, etc) in the Filter Content area.



This is essentially a playlist recommendation guide programmed by producers or eventually users. Although it is presented in a station listing format, there is no time associated with each piece of content. The user may watch anything at any time. Eventually users will get to know what stations they like and can check here for recommendations. **Simulated Station Listings** Programming is listed in a program guide format. 




### **Computer Detail**

User may change devices via drop-down menu.


#### **This Computer Media View**

The Download Manager screen allows the user to view queued downloads, cancel, change priority or pause.


### **Downloading Media**

Displays details of downloading or queued media. Items may be moved up or down in priority by dragging or selecting and using up/down buttons.

#### Pause/ Cancel Downloads

User may cancel or pause a download by selecting the item and pressing the button.

All downloads may be paused by pressing "Pause all downloads." When activated the user is allowed to choose whether to resume after a user defined period or to wait for a manual restart.



#### **Download Status**

Displays status of current downloads. Once an item can be played, a play button appears next to it.






